	<p>These free activities are generally always available at Savasi Island and don't require pre-booking. Just let staff know what interests you once you arrive - or check the activities board for our daily recommendations.</p>	
<b>Snorkeling (house reef)</b>	<p>Available directly from our house reef, there are some great snorkelling spots to explore surrounding the island. Please ask our activities team for guidance. All gear including fins, masks, snorkels and life jackets are available in the activities room. We recommend wearing reef shoes. Please take special care not to tread on the coral or touch marine life.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Moderate to Challenging Note: Activity can be more challenging depending on the current.</p>	Free
<b>Stand up paddle-boarding</b>	<p>Paddle-boards, paddles and life jackets are available at our activities center. We recommend exploring the gentle waters of our marina and surrounding mangrove canals.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Challenging</p>	Free
<b>Kayaking</b>	<p>Kayaks, paddles and life jackets are available at our activities center.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy</p>	Free
<b>Blowhole</b>	<p>You can enjoy the majestic sight of the natural blowholes right from our restaurant – or get up close and personal, by kayaking across the canal to the coral flat. We recommend wearing reef shoes.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy</p>	Free
<b>Handline fishing</b>	<p>Hand line fishing is one of the oldest forms of fishing, employed by many Fijians. This requires more angling skill than you might think! Our team will be happy to show you how it is done.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy</p>	Free
<b>Volleyball</b>	<p>Fijians love a game of volleyball so why not have a game with the activities team on the beach. This is great tropical fun for all ages.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy</p>	Free

<b>Hiking</b>	<p>Take a gentle walk or a more serious hike through the tropical Fijian jungle. A range of rainforest experiences await you, accessible by foot or by car. Please ask staff for guidance and avoid hiking without letting us know.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy, Moderate or Challenging depending on routes. What to bring: Comfortable closed shoes, a hat, insect repellent, bottled water.</p>	Free
<b>Guided rockpools and reef walk</b>	<p>Our house reef is brimming with life at low-tide and there are many beautiful rock pools to explore. Ask our activities team for guidance and take special care not to tread on the coral or touch the marine life.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy What to bring: We recommend wearing reef shoes, sunscreen and a hat.</p>	Free
<b>Garden tour</b>	<p>Take an informative and wholesome stroll through Savasi's organic garden to experience first hand our fresh and seasonally grown produce in a true farm to table journey. Learn how pineapples grow, taste a banana straight off the tree, visit the papaya plantation and chat to our resident gardener who can show you what you can expect to find on your plate at Savasi.</p> <p>Level of difficulty: Easy</p>	Free
<b>Cooking Class</b>	<p>Let our experienced chefs guide you through the preparation of a dish like banilolo (steamed coconut bread) or kokoda (fresh walu in coconut cream), a refreshing Fijian specialty. <b>Fijian Church Experience</b>	<p>Experience a Sunday church service where you'll enjoy the soulful harmonies of the choir, and hear a pastor address his congregation. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.</p>	<p>\$40.00 per adult \$20.00 per child</p>

<b>Savusavu town &amp; market</b>	Savusavu market boasts a myriad of fresh fruit and vegetables, as well as unique local foods like cassia bark (cinnamon), bush dhaniya (coriander), wild honey, avocado, cabacaba lobster, fresh mullet and sici shells. It is best visited on a Saturday. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.	\$40.00 per adult \$20.00 per child
	Level of difficulty: Easy What to bring: Bottled water, a hat, sunglasses, cash or card if you wish to make a purchase in town. Modest dress is recommended, with ladies having shoulders and knees covered, while men opt for T-shirts and knee length shorts.	
<b>Savusavu Hot Springs</b>	Suitable to visit in conjunction with Savusavu town tour and market. Savusavu is famed for its naturally occurring geothermal hot springs which can be found bubbling throughout the area. For decades, the locals have cooked in the boiling natural waters that course through their town. Visitors can have a chance to visit some of the popular spots where noodles, chicken, and many other things can be found boiling in the earth like a natural kitchen.	See above
	Level of difficulty: Easy What to bring: A hat, comfortable walking shoes, cash or card if you wish to make a purchase in town.	
<b>Hinterland Salt Lake River Kayaking</b>	A guided kayak down the peaceful Qaloqalo River, past beautiful mangrove forests, to the remote Salt Lake. Here, you'll experience the pure tranquility and silence of Savusavu's untouched hinterland. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.	\$130.00 per adult
	Level of difficulty: Easy What to bring: A hat, sunglasses, bottled water, reef shoes and bathers if you wish to swim. Sunscreen is recommended. Provided: Towels	
<b>Split Rock snorkel</b>	Snorkel to Split Rock, 150 metres off shore in Savusavu Bay. This large coral head is named for the distinctive split down one side. At the bottom of the split you can see purple gorgonian fans and pale yellow soft corals. Please note, strong swimming ability is required to swim from the shore to Split Rock. The location is reached by car from Savasi Island and includes return transport cost.	\$75.00 per adult
	Level of difficulty: Moderate What to bring: Bathers, bottled water, reef-safe sunscreen, reef shoes or thongs Provided: Towels and snorkelling gear	

<b>Moonlight Snorkeling</b>	Experience a different world beneath the oceans surface after dark. The reef comes alive, with corals opening up like flowers and shrimp scampering like bees to their honey. This breathtaking guided experience is rewarding for whoever gives it a try!	\$70.00 per adult

<b>Hot Springs Bathing &amp; Urata Lookout Cafe</b>	Take the plunge to see and bathe in Savusavu's natural volcanic hot mud pool lagoon for a truly intrepid wellness experience. Said to be great for the skin, and ease aches and pains, the locals swear by the therapeutic and medicinal benefits of absorbing the volcanic heat. Cover yourself in head to toe in glorious mud for some good old fashioned relaxation and fun. Approximate 40 minute drive and includes return transport.	\$100.00 per adult \$50.00 per child

<b>Nukubalavu village tour</b>	Take a guided tour into the cultural heart of Fiji by visiting a traditional village and meeting the beautiful local people who call this communal way of life their home. Be treated to a display of traditional song and dance, enjoy their warm hospitality, and make sure you don't decline the chance to join in for some fun and laughter.	\$60.00 per adult \$30.00 per child
