Snorkeling (House Reef)

No charge

Available directly from our house reef, there are some great snorkelling spots to explore surrounding the island. Please ask our activities team for guidance. All gear including fins, masks, snorkels and life jackets are available in the activities room. We recommend wearing reef shoes. Please take special care not to tread on the coral or touch marine life.

Kayaking

Paddle through crystal-clear waters, past lush mangroves and hidden coves—tropical kayaking combines adventure, nature and fitness in one.

Stand Up Paddle Boarding

Paddle-boards, paddles and life jackets are available at our activities center. We recommend exploring the gentle waters of our marina and surrounding mangrove canals.

Blowhole

Handline Fishing

Hand line fishing is one of the oldest forms of fishing, employed by many Fijians. This requires more angling skill than you might think! Our team will be happy to show you how it is done.

Level of Difficulty: Easy

Cooking Class

Let our experienced chefs guide you through the preparation of a dish like banilolo (steamed coconut bread) or kokoda (fresh walu in coconut cream), a refreshing Fijian specialty. You'll learn about some staple local ingredients and how to weave them into tantalising Fijian cuisine

Guided Rockpool & Reef Walk

No charge

Our house reef is brimming with life at low-tide and there are many beautiful rock pools to explore. Ask our activities team for guidance and take special care not to tread on the coral or touch the marine life. We recommend wearing reef shoes, sunscreen and a hat.

Volleyball

River Tubing Vunivesi River

\$135 per Adult | \$65 per Child

This fun tour includes a leisurely float on the tranquil Vunivesi river, with gentle currents, small rapids and vibrant tropical landscapes. The adventure begins with a scenic 40 minute drive to Vunivesi and ends with the opportunity to meet the local village children. Round-trip transportation from Savasi island is included. Bring bottled water, bathers and a hat. Towels provided.

Moonlight Snorkeling

\$70 per Adult

Experience a different world beneath the oceans surface after dark. The reef comes alive, with corals opening up like flowers and shrimp scampering like bees to their honey. This breathtaking guided experience is rewarding for whoever gives it a try!

Level of Difficulty: Moderate

What to Bring: Bathers and reef shoes.

Provided: Towels, underwater torches.

Hinterland Salt Lake River Kayaking

\$150 per Adult

A guided kayak down the peaceful Qaloqalo River, past beautiful mangrove forests, to the remote Salt Lake. Here, you'll experience the pure tranquility and silence of Savusavu's untouched hinterland. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.

Level of Difficulty: Easy

What to Bring: A hat, sunglasses, bottled water, reef shoes and bathers if you wish to swim.

Split Rock Snorkel

\$75 per Adult

Snorkel to Split Rock, 150 metres off shore in Savusavu Bay. This large coral head is named for the distinctive split down one side. At the bottom of the split you can see purple gorgonian fans and pale yellow soft corals. Please note, strong swimming ability is required to swim from the shore to Split Rock. The location is reached by car from Savasi Island and includes return transport cost.

Level of Difficulty: Moderate

What to Bring: Bathers, bottled water, reef-safe sunscreen, reef shoes or thongs.

Provided: Towels, underwater torches.

Fijian Church Experience

\$40 per Adult | \$20 per Child

Experience a Sunday church service where you'll enjoy the soulful harmonies of the choir, and hear a pastor address his congregation. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.

Level of Difficulty: Easy

What to Bring: Bottled water, hat and sunglasses

Savusavu Hot Springs

Suitable to visit in conjunction with Savusavu town tour and market. Savusavu is famed for its naturally occurring geothermal hot springs which can be found bubbling throughout the area. For decades, the locals have cooked in the boiling natural waters that course through their town.

Visitors can have a chance to visit some of the popular spots where noodles, chicken, and many other things can be found boiling in the earth like a natural kitchen.

Level of Difficulty: Easy

What to Bring: A hat, comfortable walking shoes, cash or card if you wish to make a purchase in town.

Savusavu Town & Market

\$40 per Adult | \$20 per Child

Savusavu market boasts a myriad of fresh fruit and vegetables, as well as unique local foods like cassia bark (cinnamon), bush dhaniya (coriander), wild honey, avocado, cabacaba lobster, fresh mullet and sici shells. It is best visited on a Saturday. Includes return transport from Savasi Island.

Level of Difficulty: Easy

What to Bring: Bottled water, a hat, sunglasses, cash or card if you wish to make a purchase in town. Modest dress is recommended, with ladies having shoulders and knees covered, while men opt for T-shirts and knee length shorts.

Nukubalavu Village Tour

\$60 per Adult | \$30 per Child

Take a guided tour into the cultural heart of Fiji by visiting a traditional village and meeting the beautiful local people who call this communal way of life their home. Be treated to a display of traditional song and dance, enjoy their warm hospitality, and make sure you don't decline the chance to join in for some fun and laughter

Level of Difficulty: Easy

Hot Springs Bathing & Urata Lookout Cafe

Manta Ray Excursion – Rabi Island

Encounter a stable population of manta rays around the vibrant reefs of Rabi Island from April to November. These graceful creatures feed on the surface and frequent cleaning stations just beneath, offering a mesmerizing spectacle. Snorkelling and freediving provide excellent opportunities to observe these gentle giants in their natural habitat.

Nakowaqa Waterfall Guided Hike

At 80km long, 15km wide and with a surface area of over 1000 square km, Natewa Bay is the largest bay in the South Pacific, renowned for crystal clear waters and its stunning seascape. The bay abounds with pristine coral reefs showcasing vibrant hard and soft corals that support healthy populations of fish, sharks, rays and turtles. It's also home to two resident pods of spinner dolphins, and whales can occasionally be seen. Refreshments are provided.

Savusavu is home to the prestigious J. Hunter Pearls Fiji, sought after for their pearls of unique colours such as pistachio, gold, peacock and burgundy. Discover their story on an educational pearl farm tour and learn about the process of culturing pearls and the ecological benefits pearl farms have on the surrounding marina environment and communities. Enjoy a boat ride to the Nawi farm site and have the chance to snorkel amongst the oysters. Once back aboard, the oyster tasting begins, followed by a cruise passing a smaller farm and stopping over at Split Rock for additional snorkeling. The tour ends at the pearl showroom, with the design team available should you like to “create your own” special gift. Tours run from Mon–Friday, with a minimum 6 guests and if minimum numbers are not reached, you will still have the option of booking a private tour at a total cost of FJ\$1,000.
